COMANCHE PILOT PROFICIENCY PROGRAM (CPPP)

CPPP Clinics are FAAST recognized for Wings credits

Full Course Cost: Flight school and ground school was \$750. With the Maurice Taylor discount, \$500.00 if registered and paid **before** July 25th, 2020.

Ground Course Only: Was \$450.00. With the Maurice Taylor discount only \$300.00 if registered and paid **before** July 25th, 2020

Course Outline:

Saturday, August 8th, Ground Course 8am – 5 pm

Ground course covers FAA (BFR) flight review requirements, plus Comanche systems including: Landing gear, brakes, weight & balance, performance, fuel, electrical, vacuum, etc.

Sunday, August 9th, Flight Day 7:30 am to 5 pm.

Flights divided between morning and afternoon time slots

Those flying in the afternoon will receive ground school training in the morning. 8 am to 11 am.

Those flying in the morning will receive ground school training in the afternoon 12 pm to 3 pm.

Sunday's ground school discussion consist of power plants, propellers, etc., followed by hands on demonstrations of landing gear emergency extension procedure, with the CFF/CPPP exclusive landing gear simulator, as well as actual Comanche on jacks if there are jacks and a plane available.
